Call for rate and times

From The Superintendent

October is a very busy and beautiful month at Riverside Country Club.

Our biggest maintenance challenge during October is keeping up with the leaves. We are using blowers to remove leaves from primary play areas and mowers to mulch the leaves in the rough.

Of primary interest to the members is the aerification processes to the golf course. Greens will be core aerified and toppedressed with sand. The fairways will be sliced in two directions. The rough areas will be sliced at least once. The tees were solid, deep tine aerified in September. All areas of the golf course have been fertilized to promote healing and root development.

The irrigation system will be blown out in mid-October. This process will take place over three days. The greens, tees, and fairways will receive a fungicide application in an effort to prevent snow mold injury. These spray applications will take at least a week of dry weather to complete. Dry weather is required during applications to ensure maximum efficacy of the fungicide. The grass cannot be mowed once these fungicide applications have been made.

The greens and collars will be deep tine aerified in late October to early November. This aerification process will assist in removing water from the surface of the greens in an effort to minimize ice build-up.

Finally, a moderate layer of sand will be applied to the greens, collars, approaches, tees, range tee, and various fairway areas.

Hopefully, the weather will make for a good month of playing conditions. As always, frost delays can be expected this time of year.

Thank you for your continued support and encouragement.
